## JON HASSLER FESTIVAL ESSAY WRITING CONTEST

## **PROMPT**

Jon Hassler was a local author, and his first novel, *Staggerford*, presents his perspective on life here in central Minnesota. For this contest, please analyze a theme in *Staggerford* and trace that theme's development throughout the course of the novel. Provide examples (quotes) from the novel that support your analysis.

## **JUDGING**

The process involves a blind evaluation where the names and school association are removed after submission. Judges will look for writing that is clear, articulate and logically organized.

## **RULES**

- 1. Contest is open to high school seniors from the following counties: Aitkin, Cass, Crow Wing, Mille Lacs, Morrison, Todd, & Wadena.
- 2. Strong submissions will include an original thesis, ample evidence, and be written in accordance with the Modern Language Association (MLA) format. Include a Works Cited page.
- 3. Submissions should range from 750 1,500 words and be in Standard English.
- 4. Essays must be solely the work of the entrant although instructors may review and comment on student work before it is submitted. Plagiarism will result in disqualification.
- 5. Essays must include a cover sheet stapled to the essay for submission. The cover sheet needs to have the following information:
  - a. Entrant's name
  - b. Entrant's mailing address
  - c. Entrant's school
  - d. Name of Instructor who assigned the essay or reviewed essay before submission. If no instructor was associated then please note this as "Instructor NA"
- 6. One entry per student.
- 7. Essays must be mailed to the following address and **postmarked no later than February 27**, **2015**:

- 10. Winners and students receiving honorable mentions will be notified on or around May 4, 2015.
- 11. Students chosen as one of the winners will also receive complimentary registration to the Jon Hassler Festival being held at CLC on June 14-15. This registration is to be used by the winning student only and is non-transferable nor can it be redeemed for cash value. It is for complimentary registration to this Festival only.
